SEWER RATE ADJUSTMENTS



RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS

The new sewer rate average is reflected on this bill. The city averages your water usage from November 10th through February 10th each year and you are billed that amount each month. We use these dates because most residents do not use their irrigation system during these winter months and it helps keep our rate as low as we can for our customers. This sewer rate will be the same for the next 12 months on each of your bills.

COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS

In the past the City of Hudson Oaks commercial sewer rates were based on your average water usage on the winter months from November 10th through February 10th. Effective on this bill, all commercial customers are being billed based on their monthly usage and you will be billed for your current usage not your winter average. Your sewer bill will change each month based on your usage and you will no longer have one sewer amount for the entire year. We only use your domestic meters so your irrigation usage is not calculated in the sewer rate.
