The Gene L. Voyles Park Master Plan was approved at the February City Council meeting. This comprehensive planning document provides a long-term vision and implementation roadmap for the future development and improvement of the park. Adoption of the Master Plan was a critical step for the city, as it is often a prerequisite for pursuing external funding sources, including state and federal grant opportunities.

The planning process included community surveys to gather public input, stakeholder workshops, site analysis, and professional evaluation of existing park conditions.

- Essential infrastructure improvements throughout the park

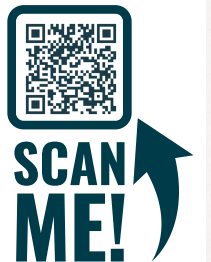
We're excited to bring this vision to life in the coming years and continue making Hudson Oaks the best place to live, shop, and have fun!
