

WATER QUALITY REPORT

The Hudson Oaks Annual Water Quality Report (also known as an annual consumer confidence report) is now available on the City website at <u>WWW.HUDSONOAKS.COM</u>, and hard copies of the report are available at City Hall (210 Hudson Oaks Drive).

The Annual Water Quality Report provides information about the quality of your drinking water. The report includes information about the source/s of water, contaminants, water quality, compliance with drinking water rules, and educational health information.

The TCEQ requires every community public water system to generate and make available a CCR to their customers by July 1 of every year, which includes information from the previous calendar year. The direct link to the Hudson Oaks report is below:
