UTILITY BILL PAYMENT OPTIONS

The City of Hudson Oaks offers several methods for paying your utility bill, which includes charges for water service, sewer service, trash service, and/or stormwater fees.

(1) Online payments: You can make payments using our online platform (https://www. municipalonlinepayments.com/hudsonoakstx). You'll need to register for an account and then link your utility account using your account #. (2) Automatic credit card payments: using the same online platform, you can add your credit/debit card for automatic payments. (3) Automatic draft: You can come into city hall, or click this link (https://hudsonoaks. com/documents/utilities/automatic-draftapplication.pdf), to fill out the form to sign up for automatic drafting, which means we'll pull your bank account to cover your bill each month. (4) Over the phone: You can pay with a credit card by calling 682-229-2400. Make sure to have your account number handy. (5) By mail via check: You can mail your check to 210 Hudson Oaks Dr. Hudson Oaks, TX 76087 (6) In-person: Swing by City Hall to pay your bill

DEER POPULATION

The Hudson Oaks community offers a semi-rural residential environment that brings urban wildlife, people, and domestic pets close together. While it can be alluring and entertaining, the interactions between these three groups can pose hazards, including public safety concerns for the community.

Of particular concern in Hudson Oaks is the overabundant deer population. More frequent interactions between people and deer are leading to, among other problems: (1) threat of disease, (2) traffic accidents, (3) costly property damage, and (4) health issues for the deer population.

According to the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department, "the prohibition of feeding deer is critical to solving [the problem of] overabundance." Therefore, the City Council adopted a resolution in November 2012. The resolution asks people in Hudson Oaks to stop feeding all wildlife.
