SMART IRRIGATION REBATE PROGRAM

The SMART Irrigation Rebate Program provides up to \$200 per customer for those that install an approved Smart Irrigation Controller with flow/pressure controls, also known as weather-based or Evapotranspiration (ET) controllers. Smart Irrigation Controllers provide the appropriate watering schedule for the landscape by automatically making adjustments up to 365 times per year. These irrigation controllers use current weather data and information about site conditions (such as soil moisture, rain, wind, slope, soil, plant type, and more), and apply the right amount of water to the landscape based on those factors. WATER CONSERVATION

The Hudson Oaks water system remains in Stage 1 of our water conservation plan year-round. Stage 1 of the water conservation plan requests a mandatory reduction in outdoor irrigation to two days per week. Irrigation should occur between 6 PM and 10 AM on your respective watering days (see chart below). There is no watering on Mondays.
