## SEWER RATE ADJUSTMENTS

### RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS

Residential sanitary sewer customers serviced by COHO, sewer rates are charged based on a three-month water average. This water usage average begins on November 10th and ends on February 10th. We assume that customers rarely irrigate during this time, making those three winter months the lowest average usage months of the year. Your new rate will be reflected in your next bill.

### COMMERCIAL CUSTOMERS

Beginning March, 2024: Commercial sanitary sewer customers serviced by COHO, your sewer bill will be calculated by the water consumption for that month rather than the winter average as in previous years.
